Social Studies Equipment & Materials

Equipment and materials, which can be included in this activity:

- Single switch (as appropriate to your student)
- Step-by-Step Communicator
- Sample questions for Step-by-Step Communicator
- Yearly outlines and unit outlines for upcoming socials studies topics for the class.
- Picture communication board (where appropriate)
- Magazines or books, which have pictures for collages around the themes being studied in the socials studies topic (e.g., Different cultures who immigrated to Canada in the last century)
- Recipes that relate to a theme being studied (e.g., foods made by Haida culture)
- Objects that relate to aspects of the topic under study (object cues) to pose questions
- Experiments and materials for station work for peers to join
- Questions from teacher to help classmates study
- Answers from teacher to help check comprehension on tests
- Skill testing questions from teacher on the topic to give randomly throughout the week
