

Why We Communicate

Although many students who use AAC first learn how to request and making choices, students benefit from being able to communicate for a variety of reasons. It is important that adults recognize the various modalities students use to communicate, such as facial expression, signing, or the use of picture symbols, and respond to students' meanings.

Personal Communication Dictionary responses can be used to acknowledge the student's communicative intent, the function of communication. For example:

- 1. I see you pointing to "go".
- 2. I think you are asking to go to gym with the class.
- 3. Yes, we can go to gym, choose a partner and we'll line up.

The following shows a selection and some examples of the reasons we all communicate.
